

CNC is appointed as the exclusive FIDE agent for the search of additional sources of sponsorship and signing of corresponding contracts, subject to the agreement of the organizers.

1.2 Existing events held under aegis of FIDE, for which bidding procedures have already been opened as of the date of the present Project Business Plan as in Appendix 2.

In addition to the CNC rights described in Article 1.1, CNC is appointed as the exclusive FIDE agent for leading sponsorship negotiations on behalf of FIDE with the bidder(s), after FIDE has reached its own agreement with the bidders regarding payments that will be made to FIDE according to the existing bidding regulations.

1.3. Existing events held under aegis of FIDE, for which no bidding procedure has yet begun as of the date of the present Project Business Plan as in Appendix 3.

CNC is granted all exclusive rights, without exception, as described in Schedule 3 of the "Agreement of Shareholders of Chess Network Company" established between FIDE and Chess Lane as of June, 2010, upon approval by the CNC Project Committee for each event. In addition, FIDE transfers to CNC exclusive commercial rights to search and conclude the contracts with sponsors for all the tournaments and chess-related events, without limitation, with a view to the generation and realization of sponsorship packages. The bidding regulations for such events shall be jointly worked out by FIDE and CNC, officially approved by the CNC Project Committee and publicly announced by FIDE officials at the opening of the event's bidding procedure. Additionally, CNC will work out a set of new propositions pertaining to the organization and broadcasting of selected events, to be included in the
